the Minister of Immigration suspended the Skilled Worker in Manitoba (SWM) and International Education Stream (IES) draws due to protests. They warned that continued protests would result in another four-month suspension of draws under the Manitoba Provincial Nominee Program (MPNP), a consequence we cannot endure. [REDACTED]

The current instability in policy has rendered the Expression of Interest (EOI) scoring meaningless, turning draws into a game of chance. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Previously, the Manitoba Provincial Nominee Program, under Conservative management, was stable and reliable.

However, due to protests [REDACTED] the Minister has continuously suspended draws, which is an immature approach and harms the interests of those who could have been selected.
