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BreastCheck, Manitoba's breast cancer screening program, has in the past recommended that most average-risk women aged 50-74 have a screening mammogram every two years. BreastCheck's recommendations currently align to guidelines published by the Canadian Task Force on Preventive Health Care (CTFPHC).

However, the CTFPHC guidelines regarding breast cancer screening are currently under review, with a draft update expected in the spring of 2024. If the new CTFPHC guidelines recommend changes to our provincial program or new evidence becomes available, we will be pleased to implement those changes. The Manitoba government is committed to ensuring women receive the screening when most needed, and when the most complications can be prevented.
